There's people looking at this from both the toolchain and kernel points of view on Arm and x86 and work on getting KernelCI able to provide good automated testing coverage.

Plumbers seems like a great time to have a BoF to sync up about how to approach things, getting toolchain enginers and kernel engineers from different companies together.
